SCOPE OF SERVICES

I. SERVICE LOCATION(S)

II. DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES

- A. CONTRACTOR shall provide youth in residence at the Sacramento County Youth Detention Facility (YDF) with positive enrichment programming at the service location listed in Section I, above.
- B. CONTRACTOR's programs shall be designed to help at-risk youth successfully transition from an in-custody setting back into the community.
- C. Programs and curricula shall address the following core areas:
 - 1. Education and Career Development
 - 2. Character Development and Pro-Social Behavior
 - 3. Health and Life Skills
 - 4. Society and Crime
 - 5. Trauma Counseling
 - 6. Gang Deterrence
 - 7. Criminal Thinking
- D. CONTRACTOR shall provide services on a weekly schedule as determined by YDF managers.
- E. Progress/outcomes shall be measured and provided to COUNTY with attendance rosters and documented knowledge and perspectives.
- F. COUNTY and CONTRACTOR shall work collaboratively to establish unit programming and the appropriate program capacity to ensure clients participating in the program are adequately served.

- G. Upon mutual agreement between COUNTY and CONTRACTOR, CONTRACTOR shall meet with YDF youth on an individual basis to provide mentoring and/or life coaching.

- H. Upon mutual agreement between COUNTY and CONTRACTOR, CONTRACTOR shall participate as a member of a Multi-Disciplinary Team. MDTs are designed to provide a holistic approach to client's complex care needs and may consist of (but not limited to) youth and their families, school representatives, probation officers, mental health counselors, and other law enforcement staff. CONTRACTOR's participation in MDT includes:
 - 1. Attending MDT meetings organized by COUNTY as needed
 - 2. Providing input and assistance regarding program delivery to ensure program efficacy
 - 3. Providing input and assistance regarding transition/re-entry support services in the community as deemed appropriate
 - 4. Provide youth linkage to re-entry support services upon release from YDF by providing program and contact information based on youth's needs and locality

- I. COUNTY and CONTRACTOR shall meet as needed to discuss the goals and objectives of this Agreement, and shall also meet as necessary to address any issues with the day to day operations.
