Meeting Called To Order: 2:03 p.m.

1. Chair Update	Marlon Yarber, Chair
<p>Chair welcomed the committee members and introduced Melissa Lloyd from Child, Family and Adult Services Department. He also informed of the change from Judge Coggins to Judge Tedmon from Sacramento Superior Courts.</p> <p>An update on Final Budget was presented. A grant-funded position within the Collaborative Courts (Adult Operations) will be ending. In the Governor's budget there was a reduction of PRCS funding which will affect positions in Adult Field Operations. There was a 5.5% reduction in the Senate Bill 678 funds.</p> <p>Chair reminded the committee that last year's block grant funding was below the anticipated amount. The County Executive Office gave direction to utilize the unspent funds from last year's grant as well as tapping into the public safety sales tax. Proposition 172 is eligible to utilize and assist with budget reductions. Currently, we don't know what this year's block grant funding will be and as a committee we may have to alter some decisions. Committee members were encouraged to be vigilant on other funding opportunities that would help with the proposed items from the plan.</p> <p>Chair updated the committee that the Block Grant Plan Performance Outcomes are not yet ready but will be presented in the October 15th meeting.</p>

3. Growlersburg Conservation Camp Update	Marlon Yarber, Chair
<p>Chair briefly reminded the committee that Pine Grove was possibly closing due to low population and that Growlersburg Conservation Camp was a possible place to transfer the youth. Since the last JJCCRS meeting, the population at Pine Grove recently started to rise and it is not yet known if Pine Grove will close. A few of the Committee Members, including the Chair, had the chance to visit Growlersburg Conservation Camp. Some of the takeaways from the visit were:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Comprehensive and well-rounded program</li> <li>➤ Not a lot of promoting from CDCR on the services that the camp offers</li> <li>➤ Wide array of services</li> <li>➤ Engagement of the older and younger campers</li> <li>➤ Kids spoke well about programs. Youth that came from YDF- spoke highly of YDF</li> <li>➤ Nice culture shift- shaking hands, compliments</li> </ul> <p>Chair mentioned that he will be setting up a visit to Pine Grove and Committee members will be contacted to see if they would like to attend.</p>
