

Vacancy in the Juvenile Justice Commission of Sacramento County

The Juvenile Justice Commission (JJC) of Sacramento County was established through the provisions of Section 225 of the California State Welfare and Institutions Code. The mission of the JJC is to serve the community and its youth by encouraging positive citizenship, preventing delinquency, and advocating for the effectiveness of the Justice System.

The JJC membership shall be comprised of residents of Sacramento County, from all geographical areas and represent the ethnic diversity of the County. JJC members who are approved by the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court and the Presiding Judge of Juvenile Court will be appointed to a four (4) year term. The monthly time commitment would be 2 - 4 hours, on average.
