- ▣ Health Screenings and Health Education

- ▣ Infirmity Care, Specialty Care & Case Management
- ▣ Dental Care, Vision Exams & Optometry
- ▣ Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT)

JCHS PROGRAM SERVICES

- ▣ Physical Therapy in YDF
- ▣ Telehealth for patients at Pine Grove/Fire Camp
- ▣ Mental Health Referrals

ACCESS TO CARE

- ▣ Right to access healthcare
- ▣ Right to care that is ordered
- ▣ Right to a professional medical opinion

HOW TO ACCESS CARE

- ▣ Information is provided at intake
 - Handouts
- ▣ Medical Health Service Request (MHSR) or Dental Sick Call (DSC) forms
 - Nurse may refer patient to MD if deemed necessary.

PILL CALL & TREATMENTS

- ▣ Pill call is done on the units.
- ▣ Depending on treatments, it may be done in the screening room in the unit or in the clinic.
- ▣ Nurses provides probation with list of patients who have medications or treatments.
- ▣ Probation assists with mouth checks. (To avoid cheeking/diversion)

MEDICAL ALARM (Emergency Services)

Unit staff alerts Control



Control notifies clinic



Medical staff responds to emergencies

- Emergency equipment
- Clinic staff will determine 911 status
- Probation confers with clinic on parent/guardian notification

RIGHT TO REFUSE

- ▣ Right to refuse medication
- ▣ Right to refuse treatment
- ▣ Minors cannot refuse medication or treatment if court ordered

FIRST AID KITS

- ▣ Available on all units
- ▣ Used for minor injuries
 - Scrapes
 - Tiny cuts



DISCHARGE PLANNING

- ▣ Continuity of care to another correctional facility or community providers
- ▣ Enhance Care Management (Cal-AIM)
