- 8. Identify how to manage juveniles during facility searches: Designate a time to allow uninterrupted searches, remove juveniles from area being searched
- 9. Discuss limiting and controlling movement of juvenile workers during facility searches
- 10. Demonstrate the proper procedure for searching a room in a juvenile facility
- 11. Demonstrate the proper procedure for searching an entire housing unit of a juvenile facility
