**RESOLUTION NO. 2013-0273
ACCEPT THE COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS PARTNERSHIP'S
PLAN FOR PUBLIC SAFETY REALIGNMENT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2013-14**

WHEREAS, the Community Corrections Partnership ("CCP") has approved a plan to implement public safety realignment pursuant to Assembly Bill 109 and Assembly Bill 117, as modified, for Fiscal Year 2013-14 ("CCP Plan").

WHEREAS, the CCP Plan includes the following components, together with recommended funding for each such component: a pretrial and supervised own recognizance program, a home detention electronic monitoring program, inmate housing, inmate services, a centralized regional law enforcement crime analyst, inmate mental health services, an adult day reporting center, intensive supervision units, kiosk monitoring, crime lab services, an AB 109 prosecutor, two eligibility specialists for inmates and supervised offenders, psychotropic medication and monitoring for inmates and supervised offenders and transitional emergency housing.

WHEREAS, in accepting the CCP Plan, it is the intent of the Board of Supervisors ("Board") that such plan will serve as framework for the County of Sacramento's implementation of AB 109 during Fiscal Year 2013-14.

WHEREAS, it is the further intent of the Board that the funding identified in the CCP Plan will serve as a recommendation to the Board and that final budgetary authority over the allocation and appropriation of the available funding identified in the CCP Plan rests with the Board.

WHEREAS, to the extent that additional AB 109 revenue becomes available to the County of Sacramento for Fiscal Year 2013-14, it is the intent of the Board that the CCP will provide a recommendation to the Board as to how such additional revenue should be allocated and that the Board will make the final budgetary decision with respect to the allocation of such additional revenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Board hereby accepts the CCP Plan as a framework for the County of Sacramento's implementation of AB 109 during Fiscal Year 2013-14.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Board accepts the funding allocations identified in the CCP Plan as recommendations to the Board and reserves the right to make the final decision as to the allocation and appropriation of such funding as part of its budget process for Fiscal Year 2013-14.
