5 – Vote to Establish Subcommittees Dedicated to Community Outreach and Engagement

Background:

The CCPAB was formed, in part, to ensure that annual updates to the AB 109 Plan reflect community input, including the input of formerly incarcerated individuals. The CCPAB recognizes that there are opportunities to seek out this input, and desires to dedicate time and resources to engaging with the formerly incarcerated population and their families to solicit input on the programs and services included in the AB 109 Plan and supported through AB 109 funding.

Additionally, the CCPAB remains committed to keeping the public informed about the CCP, CCPAB, and AB 109 Plan, as described in both the AB 109 Plan 2021 Update and proposed 2022 Update. The CCPAB further recognizes that there are limitations on the public engagement that can occur at CCP and CCPAB meetings. As previously discussed during CCPAB meetings, the CCPAB desires to expand its outreach and public information efforts within the greater community.

The CCPAB has the ability to establish Ad Hoc Committees designated to a specific purpose over a limited duration. To address its desire to expand outreach to the formerly incarcerated individuals and their families as well as the greater community, the CCPAB may establish subcommittees dedicated to these efforts. If approved, each Ad Hoc Committee would be tasked with developing and implementing a plan to better engage with its designated population.

Recommendations:

- 1) Approve the formation of an Ad Hoc Committee for outreach to formerly incarcerated individuals and their families;
- 2) Approve the formation of an Ad Hoc Committee dedicated to community outreach and expanding public awareness of the CCP, CCPAB, and AB 109 Plan; and
- 3) Direct the Chair to appoint members for both committees.
