 projected CDCR AB 109 inmates, aggregate length of sentence and breakdown, county jail only
 sentence breakdown, mandatory supervision only sentence breakdown
- County jail prison inmate demographics and offense characteristics which includes gender, age, ethnicity, residency, and commitment offense
- State Parolees, Post Release Community Supervision (PRCS) and Penal Code 1170(h) inmates booked into the county jail system which also includes number of offenders released into alternative custody programs
- Number, risk assessment score, and supervision levels for Post Release Community Supervision (PRCS) offenders handled through the Sacramento Probation Department which also includes demographic and offense characteristics, number of PRCS warrants issued while offender is supervised and revocation hearings requested by the Probation Department, number of PRCS offenders who completed supervision and had their case closed for having no violations
- Number of county jail prison, parole revocation and PRCS offenders receiving services while in custody or under community supervision
