1. Call to Order:

A quorum was present. The meeting convened at 10:30 a.m.

One of the first agenda items is to connect (enroll) the youth with a school prior to their release from detention. Division Chief Johnson informed the commission that Assistant Division Chief Keith Bays and Division Chief Brian Lee will attend the next Delinquency Prevention Commission meeting at Elinor Hickey Academy to inform the commission of the work the Probation Department has done with their Youth Service Centers.
