SUMMARY OF MINUTES

December 14, 2020

CALL TO ORDER: The meeting convened via Zoom video conference at 9:34 a.m. Commissioner Dennis Dulay welcomed participants.

Approval of November 17, 2020 Meeting Minutes

- Motion to approve minutes was made by Commissioner Fred Mills; Seconded by Commissioner Jane Claar; All others present approve.

Report from Probation

- Marlon Yarber shared that Probation is currently focused on the DJJ realignment and the impact on YDF. There are ongoing discussions at the JIPCC meetings and information will continue to be shared with the JJC.
- YDF is also currently undergoing a project to replace the alarm system and cameras within the facility.
- Dave Semon shared that COVID information is shared and updated weekly on the YDF website. He also went over the YDF population report and noted that there are no positive COVID cases at YDF as of the date of this meeting. YDF has returned to on-line learning, but still has in-person classes for special education youth. Family visits and professional visits are still allowed.

Probation was excused from the meeting at 10:00a.m.

Report from the Court:

- Judge Borack shared that the state has terminated out of state placement for youth and all youth currently out of state are returning. Sacramento County only had one youth in out of state placement.

- Sarah Davis inquired about Live Scans for Commission members. Dave Semon clarified the use of the Live Scan is for the sending authority to be informed of any subsequent arrests. Commissioners are subject to Live Scan and are given badges for use when entering facilities for inspections.
- Harold Rowe and Michelle Morrow will be referred to Live Scan.

Standing Committee Reports:

- Nominations: Commissioner Fred Mills had nothing to report.
- Inspections: Commissioner Jane Claar reviewed the list of facilities to be inspected to review with the team leader. The Commissioner decided to postpone the inspection of YDF until 2021 due to COVID concerns. Commissioner Fred Mills volunteered to assist Gwen Jackson-Tucker with the inspection of the Rancho Cordova Police Department. Michelle Morrow and Harold Rowe volunteered to assist Kara Hunter with the inspection of the Children's Receiving Home.

Bylaws:

- Commissioner Dennis Dulay requested that the discussion on the Bylaws be tables until the January 2021 meeting so that the group had time to review proposed changes.
- Judge Borack stated that she would share a Special Directive from the Los Angeles District attorney regarding Youth Justice.
- Harold Rowe and Michelle Morrow volunteered to lead the discussion on this directive at the January 2021 meeting.

New Business

- The Commission rescheduled their January 2021 meeting to January 22, 2021 until further discussion regarding a new meeting date and time.
