My current role is a Lead Community Intervention Worker for the Juvenile Trauma Response Court. I support and advocate for youth who have entered the justice system using a holistic approach in hopes to reduce recidivism. As a community intervention worker, I look past the surface of the nature of their crimes but the multiple contributing factors or root causes to allege crimes committed. I previously was a counselor for Sacramento Job Corps where I led focus groups that were culturally atoned and aligned with relevant current events. During my tenure at the Office of the Inspector General Office Prison oversight I learned a lot about laws and regulations within prisons and jails systems which piqued my interest in advocacy and effective programing within rehabilitation centers. As a community organizer with Justice2Jobs I am able to advocate and create change in grassroots organizing space. Above all my personal experience with visiting my brother when he was in and out of the Juvenile system as a young teen from being housed in Alameda Country to his transfer to Sacramento County (YDF) all I can remember was this was not a place for him to sit get well in a cell. This of many things really jumpstart my career with working with justice involved youth and young adults.
