OPERATIONS ORDER**

**APPOINTMENT AND QUALIFICATIONS – TITLE
XV 1320**

Purpose and Scope

The Sacramento County Youth Detention Facility recruits and hires employees who possess knowledge, skills and abilities appropriate to their job classification and duties in accordance with civil service or merit based rules. All sworn personnel must meet the minimum standards for selection and training as adopted by the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) pursuant to Section 6035 of the Penal Code.

Employee qualifications include a medical evaluation and physical examination including tuberculosis screening test and evaluation for immunity to contagious illnesses of childhood (i.e. diphtheria, rubeola, rubella, and mumps).

Pursuant to Section 1031 of the Government Code, a background investigation, including a criminal records check and a psychological exam, is completed on each new employee.

Contract personnel, volunteers, and other non-employees of the facility, who may be present at the facility, shall have such clearance and qualifications as may be required by law, and their presence at the facility shall be subject to the approval and control of the facility Chief Deputy


