Personal Hygiene – Title XV 1485, 1486, 1487 and 1488

Purpose and Scope Personal hygiene is encouraged and may not be denied as a form of discipline. Hygiene items may be monitored/modified or temporarily suspended as a safety measure when a youth is actively threatening to hurt themselves, others, or to destroy county property, these measures would require Supervisor approval.


I. Guidelines

- A. Youth will be issued a hygiene bag containing, a toothbrush, toothpaste, comb or pick, and deodorant upon arrival to a unit.
- B. Females will be issued panty-liners, tampons, or sanitary napkins upon request.
- ~~C. Youth will be provided with shower items such as soap, shampoo, lotion and post-shower conditioning hair products.~~
- D. Youth shall have access to a razor and shaving implements daily unless their appearance must be maintained for reasons of identification in court. All youth shall have equal opportunity to shave face and body hair. Should a youth be deemed a danger to him or herself, the Duty Supervisor may suspend the shaving requirement.

Youth shall not be required to share any personal care items listed A through D. Liquid Soap provided through a common dispenser is permitted.

- E. Youth will be permitted to shower daily and to brush their teeth after every meal.
- F. Youth will be provided with hair care services once per month. Equipment will be sanitized between each haircut/procedure in accordance with the State Board Barbering and Cosmetology, Title 16 Chapter 9 section 979 and 980 California Code of Regulations.
